Rt. 531/31 Construction Update

Rt. 31 between Rt. 531 and & Rt. 260 (Sweden-Walker Rd.) will be CLOSED to all WESTBOUND traffic as of MONDAY MAY 14th. Detours will be posted. "Recommended" routes are in the Travel Info document.

Team Drop-off/Bus Parking/Etc.

To hopefully make this a smooth process for all involved please note the instructions below and refer to the attached map.

Team Drop-off/"Camp" Area

Buses will enter the access road from the WEST (by the SERC). The road will be ONE WAY ONLY prior to the meet.

Teams should be dropped off and enter the facility at the east gate (backstretch side).

Teams should setup their camps in the field behind the backstretch bleachers. The College has requested that teams do not use "long" tent stakes. Use your best judgement with this. If you happen to have "longer" stakes, I'd suggest staying closer to the fence as to not be poking large holes in the playing field.

Please keep your areas clean and remind your athletes to use the provided trash cans.

Bus Parking

Buses that are staying will park at the <u>AD Oliver Middle School</u> (Not in the College parking lots)
After dropping off, buses should continue back to New Campus Drive and turn RIGHT. At the 4 way stop they will again turn RIGHT and continue to the Middle School parking lot(s) on their right.

Team Pickup/Departure

You can either take the short walk to your buses at the Middle School or call your drivers for pickup. If picking up, please have them enter from the WEST as they did when they dropped your team off.

<u>Spectator Info Parking/Admission/Etc.</u> (Admission is the 2017 price if different it will be communicated) Spectators should park in either Lot T (East of Tuttle Complex) of Lot V (West of the SERC). Spectators should enter the stadium via the West (frontstretch side) gate. Admission will be \$5 per person (families of 3 or more in the <u>same family</u> \$15). Anyone leaving the College stadium should retain their ticket stub and/or get their hand stamped for re-admission.

Concessions, etc.

We will be having a food truck rodeo on the BCSD campus just south of the College track (there is a gate by the shot put area). The concession stand at the High School track will be open in the AM. The College may also being be running a small concession area (not confirmed). We are providing the water table like last year as well.

Clerking Area/Warmups/Infield Access

Athlete clerking for track events will be at the South end of the main grandstand. Athletes may check in and then continue warming up in the field to West of the main grandstand. The clerk(s) will bring the athletes to the track as a group. NO TRACK ATHLETES WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE INFIELD UNLESS THEY ARE BROUGHT THERE BY THE CLERK.

Field event athletes will check in at their event areas. Please refer to the event list for exact field event locations as we will be using both facilities.

Athlete Warmup Areas (PLEASE SHARE THIS WITH YOUR ATHLETES)

The High School track with the exception of the areas being used for field events is available for warmups. There will be hurdles & steeple barriers available if the athletes need them. If anyone wants to practice handoffs, this is where it should be (not at the college).

After checking in with the clerk, the athletes will be instructed to go to the field behind the West (front stretch) bleachers to continue warming up. They will be brought to the track by an official when their events are up. They will need to be in uniform and proper footwear at this time. All extra items (clothing, etc.) need to be left at the warmup area or with someone else.

For field events contested inside the college track, athletes should complete their general warmup at one of the above listed areas. Upon entering their competition areas, they can get their marks, etc., but they must remain in the "D-zones" and not be on the turf.

Field Event Competitors and Volunteer Workers

For the events contested inside the college track, please use the gates listed below to access the event areas:

Boys & Girls Long Jump-Gate by 200m start

Boys and Girls Triple Jump- Gate by 200m start

Girls Pole Vault-Gate by Finish Line

Infield Access for Coaches (FIELD EVENTS ONLY)

Each school will be given two coach passes to access the infield to coach their athletes at the field event areas listed above. Coaching of athletes in track events must be done from outside the fence.

Field Event Notes

Per the Monroe County Handbook, at 10:00am competition will begin in: Boys TJ, Girls LJ, Boys PV, Boys SP and Girls DT.

As was voted on at the preseason meeting, PV will be contested on one runway this year. Warmups will end and competition will begin **PROMPTLY at 10:00am** so that we can finish the event in a timely fashion. Please plan your arrival so that your athletes can complete their warmup and be ready to compete at 10:00am.

TRAVEL ADVISORY – COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP MEET

Route 31 West between Route 531 and Sweden-Walker Road is under construction and **CLOSED** to Westbound traffic.

Therefore, for those coming to SUNY Brockport for the Counties:


If you coming from an area along or in close proximity to the 104 corridor, (Hilton, Greece, Spencerport, Irondequoit, Webster) use 104 or the parallel options north of 104 (Peck Rd, Ireland Rd).

If you are coming from other areas to the east or south of 104, I would recommend you take:

- 490 West to 531 West.
- Exit 531 at Union St in Spencerport (Route 259).
- Proceed to the end of the exit ramp and turn LEFT onto Union St (259).
- In approximately 150 yards you will see a RIGHT turn for Colby St.
- TURN RIGHT onto Colby St. Take Colby Street until it dead ends at Route 19 (Lake Rd) in Brockport. (5 miles +)
- TURN RIGHT onto Route 19 (heading North). This will take you into Brockport.
- TURN LEFT on Route 31 and look for signs on the right for SUNY Brockport

If you would possibly be taking the Thruway (Canandaigua, Victor), exit at Exit 47 and follow Route 19 to Brockport

These are the quickest routes. Plan ahead and leave early.
