

Penfield's own Doreisha Davis graduated in 1997 as one of Penfield's most decorated track and field athletes. She was a factor in the sprints and long jump in Section Five during her entire four year track career. She won five titles in Class A, two in the 100m dash, one in the 200m dash, one in the long jump and the other as a member of the 400m relay.

Doreisha also competed in four state meets in seven individual events, the 100m, 200m and the long jump, and twice as a member of Penfield's 400m relay. In her first three state meets she earned a 2nd, a 5th, and a 6th in the 100m dash. She also picked up a Federation 2nd place at that distance. Her relay team also had a 4th place finish.

Her senior year saw her greatest success in the 200m. She won both the D-1 state championship and the Federation Championship.

Doreisha owns two top five all-time Section Five performances having run the 5th fastest 100m dash, 12.02 and the 2nd fastest 200m dash with a 24.29. She also has two top fifteen all time performances for indoor track in the 55m dash and the long jump.

Doreisha continued her track career at Division I Middle Tennessee State.
