

Section V Class A1 Championships at Penfield

1. 2 spectators per athlete.
2. No contact tracing so athletes do NOT need to specify who will attend. Schools do NOT need to provide a list of spectators.
3. There will be NO fee at the entrances, the district will cover that cost.
4. All spectators must wear masks to get in and should wear them throughout the meet.
5. Buses can drop the teams off at the stadium and then park in the senior lot, left side adjacent to the main entrance.
6. Each team will be assigned an area where they can put up a tent and there will be a garbage bag attached for self-clean up.
7. The infield will be closed until the last relays.
8. Hip numbers will be in the long house.
9. We will need a tent for the clerking
10. Water stations placed throughout
11. No concessions
12. We will be using two pole vault pits. The north side pit will be for the boys, the south side pit will be for the girls. If it is the opinion of the two pole vault officials and the referee (note, not the coaches) that for safety reasons, one direction is not safe, we will combine the boys and girls competing into one pit, with sexes being merged to allow the competition to run at a faster pace.
13. The boys long jump/ triple jump pit will be the west pit (towards the start of the 100m) and the girls long jump triple jump pit will be the east pit (towards the start of the 200m).
14. Pentathlon order for both boys and girls will be hurdles, high jump, shot, long jump, distance event.
15. Schools will be assigned jobs for the meet. If you have a preference, email Dave Hennessey ASAP with your request. His email is coachhenn1@ [gmail.com](mailto:coachhenn1@gmail.com). Jobs will be posted on Tuesday
16. Only 1/4" spikes or smaller may be used.
17. Coach boxes will be created opposite the high jump pits outside the fence, at the far end of the track for long/triple jump, on the grass side of the pole vault box. These areas are for coaches only.
18. Schools need to submit their verification sheets to either Dan Graf or Dave Hennessey. Please submit those sheets by Monday at 6:00. (Dave's email address above)
19. Entries for Sectionals are due on Sunday, June 6 at 3:00. This is the time for all classes. Seeded meeting for coordinators is Monday, June 6.
