



Sodus Showdown - Track & Field Invitational

Sodus Central School District welcomes you to the 3rd Annual *Sodus Showdown*. Below is an outline of what coaches, officials, and athletes can expect under current guidance from the NYS Department of Health, Section V, and the Wayne County School Athletic Association to run a safe meet. The cooperation of the coaches and athletes will be appreciated.

Prior to Arriving at Sodus:

- Remind athletes that this meet is not open to the general public. All spectators will be turned away. Both the [track](#) and [field](#) events will be streamed live via YouTube > SCSD Live
- Please take athlete's temperatures before getting on the bus. Athletes with temperatures over 100 degrees should not board the bus and instead be sent home.
- Student-athletes may not attend the meet if in the last fourteen (14) days they:
 - Have tested positive for COVID-19.
 - Experienced symptoms of COVID-19 that are new or not usual symptoms related to seasonal allergies.
 - Knowingly been in close or proximate contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or has symptoms of COVID-19.
- Coaches will sign to verify that their athletes are cleared for participation with a Sodus Event Supervisor upon arrival to the stadium.

General Guidelines:

- Masks covering both the nose and mouth are required at all times while on school property.
 - Per NYS guidelines, masks must be worn during competition until the athlete can no longer tolerate it.
- Sodus Event Staff will be on site to monitor mask wearing and the six-foot social distancing policy.

- Sanitizer stations will be available at several locations throughout the stadium.
- Outdoor restrooms located near the concession stand will be available.
- The concession stand will be open. There will be drinks and pre-packed food available for purchase.
- In the event of inclement weather (Thunder and Lightning), teams will be notified to return to their busses until the allotted time has expired. Coaches should have their bus drivers phone number as they will be parked behind the school.

Team/Athlete Guidelines:

- Locker rooms will not be available. Teams should arrive at the stadium ready to compete.
- Water fountains will not be available. Student-athletes should bring their own water bottle labeled with their full name.
- To streamline runners getting their hip numbers, we will have a table clerk located behind the grandstand. All athletes in track events will need to clerk in there, including all four relay members.

Busing:

- Please drop off athletes at the stadium using the route shown on the map below.
- Bus drivers will have access to the Jr./Sr. High School cafeteria and restrooms via door #9 in the bus parking lot located behind the Jr./Sr. High School.
