Welcome to Caledonia-Mumford for track sectionals.

AD's please pass along to your coach and transportation department.

We do not have school Friday so that should alleviate some issues, the campus will be pretty empty.

PARKING - This is huge for us. Please, Please follow these instructions. I am attaching a map.

Buses/Vans use Hinsdale Dr. (sometimes spelled Hindsdale) which is at the north end of campus and brings you to the HS entrance, like you are coming to an event in the HS gym. Athletes will be dropped off, walk along the building and head to the grass areas to set up tents.

THIS IS NOT THE STADIUM entrance. Tent city is easier to get to AND it keeps the students and spectators safe because buses are not dropping off and circling back by the spectator entrance. The bus can then go through the bus pen on the access road and park in the grass near the burm (small hill).

TENT CITY -

We have two grass soccer fields north of the stadium, teams can set up there. There is a single gate next to the concession stand tent that they can use to enter the facility.

SPECTATORS

Spectators should use Freeman Drive, they will be directed to park and will enter to the south end of the stadium by the tennis courts. We will have a small number of traditional tickets available just in case but this will slow things down so please encourage fans to purchase online. We have workers to direct spectators to parking areas.

Please make sure coaches have some sort of ID... a lot of people just walk up and say they are a coach.
